# ABOUT THE SEMINAR

Local government uses concrete to construct various assets including footpaths, cycle ways, kerbs and gutters, pavements for high traffic areas, roundabouts, intersections, parking areas and stormwater drainage systems. Appropriate design methods and construction techniques are essential to the successful procurement of local government infrastructure. Proactive maintenance practices and systems ensure that assets serve the needs of the community over a long period of time.

CCAA, IPWEA and NATSPEC organised this seminar to raise awareness of issues in the design, construction and maintenance of concrete infrastructure and the benefits of harmonisation of concrete specifications across local government.
